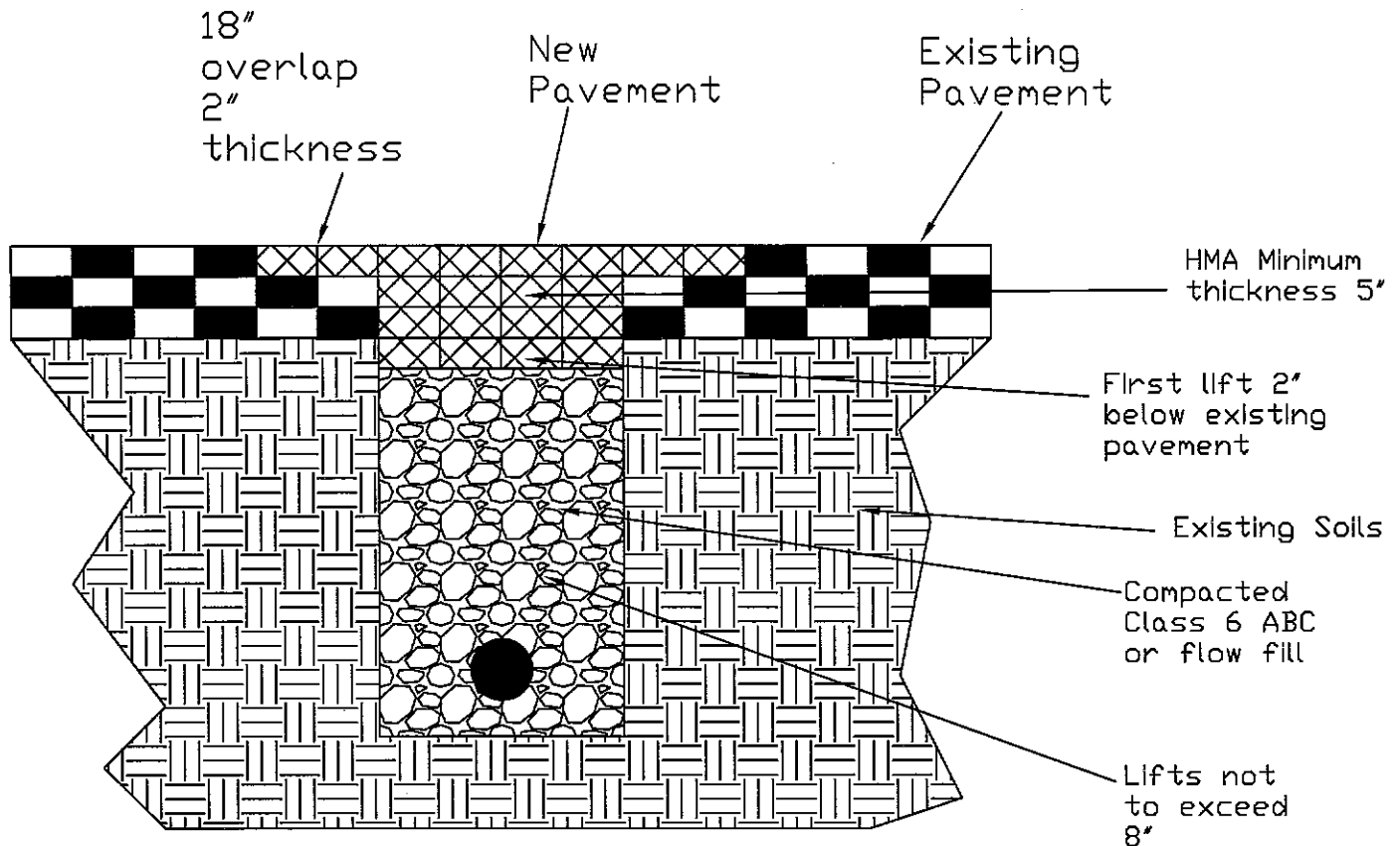
Water Tap Procedures

- 1) To obtain approval from Little Elk Creek Village Architectural Control Authority submit a plot plan showing the location of the proposed connection.
- 2) If a road cut is necessary it is the homeowner's responsibility to repair the road surface to its pre-existing condition within 45 days. See attached Pitkin County Road Cut Specification.
- 3) No water tap may can be made between November 15th and April 15th
- 4) A \$1500 Water tap fee paid to the Little Elk Creek Homeowners Association must accompany the request for approval.
- 5) Contact the Utility Notification Center for Colorado for line locates. Dial 811 and follow the voice prompts. This service is free.
- 6) Contact manager 48 hours prior to water tap. Upon completion manager will install curbstop location marker.
- 7) Any deviation from this procedure which results in a disruption of service or breakage of the water lines will require a payment of a \$1500 penalty to Little Elk Creek Homeowners' Association.

Notes:

1. Existing pavement shall be full depth saw cut. Saw cutting shall be completed after back fill and compaction and prior to paving.
2. Any pavement damage caused during excavation shall be repaired prior to final pavement placement.
3. All materials shall be compacted to a minimum of 95%.
4. All materials shall comply with the latest edition of Colorado Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction.
